RE: PRODUCT APPROVAL FOR THE FUJICLEAN ACE3000 SECONDARY TREATMENT SYSTEM

We refer to your application seeking product approval for the FujiClean ACE3000 on-site domestic wastewater treatment unit.

Approval of the product is granted on the basis that the product has been certified by Global Certification Pty Ltd to conform with:

- AS/NZS 1546.3:2017 On-site domestic wastewater treatment units Secondary treatment systems, as demonstrated by Product Certificate of Registration Number Global Certification certificate number 649, and
- AS/NZS 1546.1:2008 On-site domestic wastewater treatment units Septic tanks, as demonstrated by Global Certification certificate number 294/7.

Pursuant to the South Australian Public Health (Wastewater) Regulations 2013, product approval is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The approved secondary treatment system incorporates:
 - 1.1. A single, horizontally-oriented fibre-reinforced plastic tank, containing a sedimentation chamber, an anaerobic filtration chamber, an aerobic contact filtration chamber, a clarification chamber, and a disinfection chamber.
 - 1.2. Maximum treatment capacity 3,000L/day hydraulic load and 1,400g BOD₅/day organic load.
- 2. The products shall be manufactured and constructed in accordance with:
 - 2.1. The plans, drawings and specifications, as referenced in this approval.
 - 2.2. AS/NZS 1546.3:2017 On-site domestic wastewater treatment units Secondary treatment systems.
 - 2.3. AS/NZS 1546.1:2008 On-site domestic wastewater treatment units Septic tanks.
 - 2.4. All other relevant standards and codes.

- 2.5. Conditions of this approval.
- 3. The seller of the approved product shall provide the purchaser with an electronic or hard copy of:
 - 3.1. The "Large Domestic. Small COMMERCIAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM ACE 3000 Owner's Manual"
 - 3.2. Any other instructions relating to the installation, operation or maintenance of the product.
- 4. Modification of the design, materials or manufacturing process of the approved products or any of their associated components requires a variation to this approval by the Department for Health and Wellbeing.
- 5. The product approval will expire on **14 February 2026**, at which time the products will no longer be approved and will be removed from the SA Health approved product database.
- 6. This product approval does not constitute approval for the installation of the product.
